NATA and Other Aviation Associations Fight Airport Restrictions

On Friday, June 5th, NATA joined other aviation associations in a [letter](#) to House members opposing a possible amendment to the FY2016 Department of Transportation Appropriations bill to allow for the imposition of a night curfew at the Bob Hope Airport in Burbank, California. The associations reminded lawmakers that such amendments undermine the balanced process established by Congress to maintain a vibrant national airport system through the Airport Noise and Capacity Act of 1990. Action on the legislation will be completed this week and its low infrastructure funding levels have already drawn a [veto threat from the Administration](#).
