Founded in 1972, **the Aviation Hall of Fame and Museum** is a local museum dedicated to preserving New Jersey's aviation and space heritage. The museum highlights the outstanding aeronautical achievements of men and women who have brought worldwide recognition to New Jersey by enshrining them in their Hall of Fame. The museum displays historic aircraft, air and space artifacts, photographs, fine art, and an extensive model collection.

Every year, Signature Flight Support Teterboro shows their support for the Hall of Fame and Museum by attending their annual dinner, at which the museum recognizes three New Jersey natives who have made major contributions to New Jersey's aerospace industry.
