Arizona Bill Aims to Exempt Aircraft Registration, Parts and Transactions From Sales Tax

The Arizona state Senate is reviewing SB 1174 which aims to reduce the aircraft registration tax and exempt aircraft parts and avionics from the state's sales and use tax. During this challenging economic environment, states are making changes that encourage growth and development and SB 1174 in Arizona hopes to increase the economic contributions of the aviation industry. Aviation in Arizona contributes \$150 billion annually to the state's economy and nearly 17% of the state's total employment. The NATA State Advocacy Network is monitoring the issue and urges its members across Arizona to reach out to their [legislators](#) in support of this legislation which will ease the tax burden on the aviation industry and promote growth for aviation business across Arizona.
