### **Wisconsin Bills Aim To Exempt Aircraft Parts, Maintenance and Labor from State's Sales and Use Tax**

The Wisconsin state legislature is reviewing [AB 438](#) which reviews the sales and use tax for aircraft parts, maintenance and labor and would exempt these items from the tax. The state Senate companion bill, [SB 348](#), passed the chamber on February 18, 2014. NATA members across Wisconsin are encouraged to reach out to their elected officials and urge their support for this legislation. General aviation across the state supports more than 16,000 jobs and contributes \$1.5 billion to the state annually. Passage of this issue would level the playing field for the many Wisconsin aviation maintenance facilities that are currently unable to compete with surrounding states who have tax exemptions on aircraft parts, labor and maintenance that occur.
