New York Aviation Jobs Act Awaiting State Senate Action – Contact Your Legislators Now

As reported by the New York Aviation Management Association (NYAMA), the New York state Senate has included in its proposed [budget](#) a measure that would exempt general aviation aircraft purchased in the state from the sales and use tax. Under the Aviation Jobs Act, aviation maintenance facilities will be able to compete with businesses in neighboring states and will bolster industry job development throughout the state. NATA urges its members across New York to contact their state legislators now and ask them to support this critical legislation and include it in their final budget.
