### **General Aviation Supports Millions in Economic Activity and Thousands of Jobs Across Missouri, Governor Says**

Missouri Governor Jeremiah (Jay) Nixon has recently signed a [proclamation](#) declaring April 2014 "General Aviation Appreciation Month." The proclamation cited a Missouri Department of Transportation study which confirms that general aviation contributed \$857 million in economic activity and supports nearly 7,500 jobs statewide. "NATA and our member companies in Missouri applaud Governor Nixon's actions in recognizing general aviation as a vital resource to the state's competitiveness and growth," stated Thomas L. Hendricks, President and CEO of NATA. This is the fourth year in a row that Governor Nixon has recognized the critical role of general aviation to the wellbeing of Missouri's citizens, businesses and economy.
