Governors Recognize Value of Aviation with Proclamations

The Governors of [New Hampshire](#), [North Dakota](#), [Louisiana](#) and [Oklahoma](#) recently signed proclamations recognizing the importance of aviation to the economy and businesses to the communities across their states.
