NATA Supports Sales and Use Tax Legislation in Texas

NATA joined other general aviation associations [in letters of support](#) for legislation introduced in the Texas House and Senate that addresses industry concerns with the imposition of state sales and use taxes on aircraft. The letters emphasize that the imposition of burdensome taxes on general aviation aircraft use and purchase would force business to neighboring states. The proposed legislation allows Texas to remain competitive and “offers clear guidance on sales and use tax for future transactions, critical to managing regulatory compliance and allowing general aviation to thrive in the state.”
