Colorado Celebrates General Aviation

The Colorado Aviation Business Association (CABA) recently celebrated Colorado Aviation Week to commemorate general aviation's contributions to the state's economy, businesses and jobs. The June 7-10 event kicked off with a dedication by Governor John Hickenlooper [proclaiming June 2012 as General Aviation Appreciation Month](#). Colorado is home to 8,074 general aviation aircraft, which contribute more than \$2.9 billion to the state's economy and support 22,650 jobs.

The event included the opportunity to tour and ride in a World War II-era B-17 bomber, hosted by Signature Flight Support, the Arapahoe County Public Airport Authority and the Wings Over the Rockies Air and Space Museum. All proceeds went to scholarships awarded through CABA to further development and interest in general aviation throughout the state.
