Montana Governor Proclaims August 2014 General Aviation Appreciation Month

NATA recently joined other national aviation associations in commending Montana Governor Steve Bullock for proclaiming August 2014 "General Aviation Appreciation Month." General aviation in Montana accounts for more than \$117 million in economic activity and connects major airports to rural communities. Across the state, there are 121 public-use airports that are used by more than 2,500 aircraft and 4,000 pilots.
