USAIG to Discontinue Workers' Compensation Insurance Pool

NEW YORK, NY (Sept. 11, 2015) – USAIG, a leading international provider of a full spectrum of insurance coverage to aviation organizations, will end its Workers' Compensation pool as of Dec. 31, 2015. The change will have no effect on any other USAIG policies or coverage. All Workers' Compensation coverage currently in force and placed with USAIG before January 1, 2016 will remain in force until its normal expiration.
