Atlantic Opa-Locka (OPF) recently hosted an educational and fun-filled day of workshops with The Flying Classroom for a group of 33 educators in the Miami-Dade region. This was an amazing opportunity to host STEM classes and workshops directly to teachers who can in turn provide the skills and information back to their students.

These tailored workshops provided essential information on how STEM (Science, Technology, Education and Math) classes are utilized in real life applications in the aviation industry.
